PLAYOFF SHARE CLUB

There are multiple chances to win this season, following is an explanation of each:

Each player will randomly be assigned a team sheet (Sample shown below). Based on your weekly assigned team's success or failure will determine your winnings. FIRST, your assigned team must WIN !!! or TIE !!! (End of game score - includes overtime if any) to qualify to win in the winners categories shown below. Of the winning teams, only four (4) will be a category winner. The losing teams which played the four category winners will be a category loser and receive a loser's share of (\$6.00) each. In addition using your assigned team sheet to track your won / lost record and points could win you additional monies.

The N.F.L. season will be 17 weeks long. Each team will have one bye thus actually only playing 16 games. Each player will be in the running 16 out of the 17 weeks, with the byes being distributed equally.

HTPSG = Highest Total Points Scored Game

First tie breaker, Highest winning team score. Second tie breaker, Highest alphabetical standing using the last teams name. In case of a tie game at the end of overtime, the Highest Alphabetical Standing Team will be given the win and The other team the loss.

#2

HDSG = Highest Differential Score Game

First tie breaker; Highest winning team score. Second tie breaker, Highest alphabetical standing using the last teams name.

#3

LTPSG = Lowest Total Points Scored Game

First tie breaker, Lowest winning team score. Second tie breaker, Lowest alphabetical standing using the last teams name.

#4

LDSG = Lowest Differential Score Game

First tie breaker; Lowest winning team score. Second tie breaker, Lowest alphabetical standing using the last teams name. In case of a tie game at the end of overtime, the Lowest Alphabetical Standing Team will be given the win and The other team the loss.

The losing teams which played the above four category winners will receive \$6.00 each.

Note: The Highest Alphabetical team standing and Lowest Alphabetical team standing serving as a second tie breaker is explained below for clarity sake:

BEARS - Lowest alphabetical team standing (name)
VIKINGS - Highest alphabetical team standing (name)

HTPSG - Colts 42 - Dolphins 42 = Winner - Dolphins

HDSG - Titans 24 - Texans 24 = Winner - Titans

LTPSG - Chiefs 13 - Bears 13 = Winner - Bears

LDSG - Eagles 3 - Browns 3 = Winner – Browns

**Each winning category has a number weight. 1 = HTPSG
2 = HDSG 3 = LTPSG 4 = LDSG. The number weights through out the 17 week season will be randomly distributed. Each week the money winners will be based on the indicated**

weight column indicated below. If you are a winner, find the column your number weight is indicated in and you will know your winnings

ZERO (0) CLUB

Each week the zero club is worth \$6.00

1. If your weekly assigned team is held scoreless (zero (0) points), you will win the \$6.00 unless an other team(s) is held scoreless, which in that case you will split the \$6.00 among all scoreless team holders.

**Example - Giants 17 - Redskins 0
Ravens 20 - Bengals 0**

The Redskins & Bengals team holders will receive \$3.00 each.

2. In the event no team is held scoreless then the following week the zero club will be worth \$12.00. In other words the zero club will accumulate until a team is held scoreless. Then the zero club re-sets to \$6.00 once again.
3. In the event the zero club at the end of the week seventeen still has money not won, then the zero club will continue on into the playoff system and all playoff team holders will have a chance to win the zero pot.

PLEASE NOTE: The zero club amount accumulated at the end of week seventeen no longer accumulates when in the playoff system.

4. In the unlikely event the zero club is not depleted during the playoffs, then the LOSER of the SUPER BOWL will win the amount left in the zero club.

Using your assigned team sheet for the 17 week season (one bye week) will result in a won / loss record. For each win and loss during each week, keep track of all your

team's scores below. These points may be used as a tie breaker at the end of the season. Note: In case of a tie game at the end of overtime refer to the rule in PART B below under CATCH 22.

Most wins tie breaker rules

In case of a placement tie with most wins, **highest** total points scored will break the tie and win the monies

If points are the same then using your last name, **highest** alphabetical standing
A (lowest) Z (highest) will win the monies
Example - Russell 300 pts, Davis 300 pts

Most losses (least pts. Tie breaker)

Most losses tie breaker rules

In case of a placement tie with most losses, **lowest** total points scored will break the tie and win the monies

If points are the same then using your last name, **lowest** alphabetical standing
A (lowest) Z (highest) Example
Jones 120 pts, Thomas 120 pts

The \$480 four (4) Quarter Club

(You could win it all!)

RULES

Here is how it will work. Use your assigned 17 week team sheet **in order as assigned** and break it down into 4 quarters. If a bye comes into play then the next following team will constitute your quarter. Example below:

There are multiple chances and ways to win with a **(CATCH 22)**.

A – Each quarter is worth \$120.00. Anyone going 4 & 0 or 0 & 4 in any of their 4 quarters will qualify to divide equally into the monies for that respective quarter.

B – If a quarter goes by with no winners then the previous quarter \$120 will add to the next quarter making it \$240.

C – If at the end of the 4th quarter there are monies not won, then everyone with a **ending 8 & 8 season record** in Part A of the WIN/LOSS Record and Score Tracking Sheet will qualify to split the monies equally.

D – Now for the **CATCH 22**

Anyone who post a perfect season either a 16 & 0, a 0 & 16 record or wins in all four quarters with a mix of 4 wins or 4 losses in any order with their assigned teams will win or split in case of identical records the **TOTAL** \$480.00 and eliminate any winners that qualified in A, B, or C.

Tie Breaker Rule – In case of a tie game at the end of overtime, the Highest Alphabetical Standing Team will be given the win and the other team the loss.

Example – Saints 20 – Seahawks 20 at the end of overtime.
Seahawks will be given the win and the Saints will be given the loss.

AMOUNT TO BE WON OR SPLIT (???.???)

THE 37 CLUB

1. If the team your assigned during a specific week scores exactly 37 points (win or lose) end of game score including overtime you will win \$18.00, unless another team scores exactly 37 points, then you will split the money. Note: The “37 club” is not in effect during the playoffs.

NOTE: ONLY THE PERSON HOLDING THE TEAM SCORING 37 POINTS WILL WIN THE \$18.00. The \$18.00 will not be split with the person holding the second team of the game.

2. In the event no team scores 37 points exactly, then the following takes effect:

The game with the final score, (Total Points Scored) closest to 37 points will win the club. BOTH team holders will split the \$18.00. In the case of more than one identical game score, the money will be split.

If two games have a score with an even split above and below 37 points, the one under will win.

EXAMPLES * = Winner

#1 Falcons 34 - Broncos 7 = 41 Total Points Scored *
Redskins 20 - Bears 12 = 32 Total Points Scored

even Jets 20 - Cowboys 14 = 34 Total Points Scored *
split #2 Eagles 27 - Saints 13 = 40 Total Points Scored

#3 Eagles 28 - Texans 7 = 35 Total Points Scored
49ers 21 - Chiefs 17 = 38 Total Points Scored *

T. P. S. (Track)

Total Points Scored (T.P.S.) can win you monies.

Each week, keep track of the points scored (win or lose the game) by your weekly assigned team. Sixteen actual games with one bye during the 17 week season. At the end of the regular season the accumulative points scored of each of your weekly assigned teams can add up to you winning monies depending on your overall placement.

The accumulative Total Points Scored (T.P.S.) of each member's assigned team sheet will be listed in placement order starting with the Highest (#1) to the Lowest (#32) in descending order.

Example: #1 placement 456 points ----- 32nd placement 205 points

In case of a placement tie(s) the following will determine the money winner(s).

TIE BREAKER SYSTEM

1ST Tie breaker - Highest team score in week #17 will be the money winner.
If both team scores are identical then >

2nd Tie breaker - Start with week #1 and continue on through each succeeding week until one of the weeks produces a highest score. If all scores remain identical then >

3rd Tie breaker – The team assigned in week #17 with the Highest alphabetical standing using the last teams name as indicated below will break the tie and be the money winner. Bears – (Lowest) Vikings - (Highest)

NFL PLAYOFF SHARE CLUB

The sheet you were assigned as a team sheet will serve as a Qualifier to continue on into the N.F.L. Playoff System. This season there will be Twelve (12) qualifying slots.

QUALIFYING MEMBERS WILL BE ASSIGNED THEIR RESPECTIVE PLAYOFF TEAM BASED ON SEEDING OF THEIR TEAM SCORES. YOU WILL BE NOTIFIED OF YOUR ASSIGNED PLAYOFF TEAM.

On your assigned team sheet, the team your assigned for week Seventeen (17) Must Win! Keep track of the points it scored.

EXAMPLES: Broncos 21 -- Rams 16 (Points scored is 21 points)

Giants 40 -- Chargers 21 (Points scored 40 points)

If your assigned team is one of the twelve teams with the Highest winning score then you will continue on into the playoff system.

Tie breaker system in case of identical winning team scores

The team with the highest differential in score will be ranked ahead.

EXAMPLES: Raiders 34 -- Vikings 31

Redskins 34 -- Dolphins 27

First would be the Redskins due to a seven (7) point difference.

In case of Identical Scores, the Highest Alphabetical Standing using the last Team's name will break the tie.

EXAMPLE: Titans 20 -- Panthers 10

Texans 20 -- Rams 10

The Titans will be ranked higher due to Highest Alphabetical Standing.

PLAYOFF TEAMS ARE ASSIGNED BASED ON WHAT CONFERNECE WON THE SUPER BOWL THE PREVIOUS YEAR. IF THE AFC WON, THEN THE PERSON WITH THE HIGHEST WINNING SCORE WILL BE ASSIGNED AFC TEAM WITH THE BEST RECORD AND THE NEXT BEST WINNING SCORE WILL BE ASSIGNED THE NFC TEAM WITH THE BEST RECORD AND SO ON.

IF THE NFC WON THE PREVIOUS YEARS SUPER BOWL THEN THE REVERSE IS TRUE. THE PERSON WITH THE HIGHEST WINNING SCORE WILL BE ASSIGNED THE NFC TEAM WITH THE BEST RECORD AND THE NEXT WINNING SCORE WILL BE ASSIGNED THE AFC TEAM WITH THE BEST RECORD AND SO ON.
